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Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). The work of preparing International Standards is normally carried out through ISO technical committees. Each member body interested in a subject for which a technical committee has been established has the right to be represented on that committee. International organizations, governmental and non-governmental, in liaison with ISO, also take part in the work. ISO collaborates closely with the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) on all matters of electrotechnical standardization.

Draft International Standards adopted by the technical committees are circulated to the member bodies for voting. Publication as an International Standard requires approval by at least 75 % of the member bodies casting a vote.

International Standard ISO 3166 was first published in 1974. It was prepared by Technical Committee ISO/TC 46, *Information and documentation*, in collaboration with the following International Organizations: Customs Cooperation Council (CCC), [since 1995: World Customs Organization (WCO)], United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (ECE), Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), International Air Transport Association (IATA), International Chamber of Commerce (ICC), International Chamber of Shipping (ICS), International Federation of Library Associations (IFLA), International Labour Office (ILO), International Telecommunication Union (ITU), International Union of Railways (UIC), United Nations Organization (UN), United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), Universal Postal Union (UPU), World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), and World Health Organization (WHO).

This part of ISO 3166 is based on ISO 3166-1:1997. It comprises a consolidation of all changes to the lists of ISO 3166-1:1997 agreed to by the ISO 3166 Maintenance Agency (see below), published in the ISO 3166-1 *Newsletter* up to V-1.

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ISO 3166 consists of the following parts, under the general title *Codes for the representation of names of countries and their subdivisions*:

- *Part 1: Country codes*
- *Part 2: Country subdivision code*
- *Part 3: Code for formerly used names of countries*

Annexes A, B and C of this part of ISO 3166 are for information only.

Avant-propos

L'ISO (Organisation internationale de normalisation) est une fédération mondiale d'organismes nationaux de normalisation (comités membres de l'ISO). L'élaboration des Normes internationales est en général confiée aux comités techniques de l'ISO. Chaque comité membre intéressé par une étude a le droit de faire partie du comité technique créé à cet effet. Les organisations internationales, gouvernementales et non gouvernementales, en liaison avec l'ISO participent également aux travaux. L'ISO collabore étroitement avec la Commission électrotechnique internationale (CEI) en ce qui concerne la normalisation électrotechnique.

Les projets de Normes internationales adoptés par les comités techniques sont soumis aux comités membres pour vote. Leur publication comme Normes internationales requiert l'approbation de 75 % au moins des comités membres votants.

La Norme internationale ISO 3166 a été publiée pour la première fois en 1974. Elle a été élaborée par le comité technique ISO/TC 46, *Information et documentation*, avec la collaboration des Organisations internationales suivantes: Bureau international du travail (BIT), Conseil de coopération douanière (CCD) [depuis 1995, Organisation mondiale des douanes (OMD)], Chambre de commerce internationale (CCI), Comité économique pour l'Europe des Nations Unies (CEE), Organisation des Nations Unies pour l'alimentation et l'agriculture (FAO), Fédération internationale des associations de bibliothécaires (IFLA), Agence internationale de l'énergie atomique (IAEA), Association du transport aérien international (IATA), Chambre internationale de la marine marchande (ICS), Organisation mondiale de la propriété intellectuelle (OMPI), Organisation mondiale de la santé (OMS), Organisation des Nations Unies (ONU), Conférence des Nations Unies sur le commerce et le développement (UNCTAD), Union internationale des chemins de fer (UIC), Union internationale des télécommunications (UIT), Union postale universelle (UPU).

La présente partie de l'ISO 3166 est fondée sur l'ISO 3166-1:1997. Elle intègre tous les changements par rapport aux listes de l'ISO 3166-1:1997 acceptés par l'Agence de mise à jour de l'ISO 3166 (voir ci-dessous), publiés dans le bulletin *ISO 3166-1 Info-Services* jusqu'à V-1.

Introduction

ISO 3166 provides universally applicable coded representations of names of countries (current and non-current), dependencies, and other areas of particular geopolitical interest and their subdivisions.

ISO 3166-1 (Country codes) establishes codes that represent the current names of countries, dependencies, and other areas of particular geopolitical interest, on the basis of lists of country names obtained from the United Nations.

ISO 3166-2 (Country subdivision code) establishes a code that represents the names of the principal administrative divisions, or similar areas, of the countries etc. included in ISO 3166-1.

ISO 3166-3 (Code for formerly used names of countries) establishes a code that represents non-current country names, i.e. the country names deleted from ISO 3166 since its first publication in 1974.

The three parts of ISO 3166 do not express any opinion whatsoever concerning the legal status of any country, dependency, or other area named herein, or concerning its frontiers or boundaries.

NOTE ISO 3166-2 and ISO 3166-3 are not included in the same document as ISO 3166-1. They are separate parts of ISO 3166.

Introduction

L'ISO 3166 fournit une représentation codée des noms de pays (actuels ou non actuels), dépendances et autres territoires d'intérêt géopolitique particulier et de leurs subdivisions, pour une application universelle.

L'ISO 3166-1 (codes pays) établit des codes qui représentent les noms de pays actuels, des dépendances et autres territoires d'intérêt géopolitique particulier, basés sur des listes de noms de pays provenant des Nations Unies.

L'ISO 3166-2 (code pour les subdivisions de pays) établit un code qui représente les noms des divisions administratives ou des territoires similaires des pays, etc. issus de l'ISO 3166-1.

L'ISO 3166-3 (code pour les noms de pays antérieurement utilisés) établit un code pour les noms de pays attestés dans le passé, c'est-à-dire des pays dont les noms ont été supprimés de l'ISO 3166 depuis sa première publication en 1974.

Les trois parties de l'ISO 3166 n'expriment aucune opinion sur le statut légal des pays, des dépendances ou autres territoires cités, ou sur la délimitation de leurs frontières ou de leurs limites.

NOTE L'ISO 3166-2 et l'ISO 3166-3 ne font pas partie du même document que l'ISO 3166-1. Ce sont des parties séparées de l'ISO 3166.

1 Scope

This part of ISO 3166 provides the structure of a code for the representation of names of principal administrative divisions, or similar areas, of the countries etc., included in ISO 3166-1.

Clause 8 contains a list of country subdivision names, together with the code element developed for each one of them.

2 Normative references

The following standards contain provisions which, through reference in this text, constitute provisions of this part of ISO 3166. At the time of publication, the edition indicated was valid. All standards are subject to revision, and parties to agreements based on this part of ISO 3166 are encouraged to investigate the possibility of applying the most recent edition of the standards indicated below. Members of IEC and ISO maintain registers of currently valid International Standards.

1 Domaine d'application

La présente partie de l'ISO 3166 fournit la structure d'un code pour la représentation des noms des principales divisions administratives ou territoires semblables des pays, etc., inclus dans l'ISO 3166-1.

L'article 8 comporte une liste des noms de subdivisions de pays associés au codet attribué pour chacun d'eux.

2 Références normatives

Les normes suivantes contiennent des dispositions qui, par suite de la référence qui en est faite, constituent des dispositions valables pour la présente partie de l'ISO 3166. Au moment de la publication, les éditions indiquées étaient en vigueur. Toute norme est sujette à révision et les parties prenantes des accords fondés sur la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 sont invitées à rechercher la possibilité d'appliquer les éditions les plus récentes des normes indiquées ci-après. Les membres de la CEI et de l'ISO possèdent le registre des Normes internationales en vigueur à un moment donné.

3 Definitions

For the purposes of this part of ISO 3166, the following terms and definitions apply.

3.1 code

data transformation or data representation in different forms according to pre-established rules

[Adapted from: ISO 5127-1:1983, 1.1.4-06]

3.2 code element

result of applying a code to an element in a set of elements to be coded

[Adapted from: ISO 2382-4:1987, 04.02.04]

NOTE In this part of ISO 3166 a code element represents a country subdivision name.

3.3 country subdivision name

name of a unit resulting from the division of a country, dependency, or other area of special geopolitical interest contained in ISO 3166-1

4 Principles for inclusion in the list of country subdivision names

4.1 List and its sources

The list of country subdivision names in this part of ISO 3166 includes those required to satisfy the broadest possible range of applications.

4.1.1 The country subdivision names included in this part of ISO 3166 shall be those that properly reflect the subdivisions of the countries etc.,

3 Définitions

Pour les besoins de la présente partie de l'ISO 3166, les termes et définitions suivants s'appliquent.

3.1 code

NOTE Dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166, un codet représente un nom de subdivision de pays.

3.3 nom de subdivision de pays

nom d'une unité résultant de la division d'un pays, d'une dépendance ou d'un autre territoire d'un intérêt géopolitique particulier figurant dans l'ISO 3166-1

4 Principes d'insertion dans la liste des noms de subdivisions de pays

4.1 Liste et ses sources

La liste des noms de subdivisions de pays qui figure dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 comprend ceux qui s'avèrent nécessaires pour couvrir le plus grand nombre d'applications possibles.

4.1.1 Les noms de subdivisions de pays qui figurent dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 doivent être ceux qui correspondent parfaitement

included in ISO 3166-1. Names reflect the complete currently known subdivision of the countries etc., without overlaps as notified by the national authorities concerned or otherwise obtained from sources to which reference is given (see clause A.2). Lower levels of subdivisions are not represented in this part of ISO 3166.

4.1.2 A one-to-one correspondence with country names in ISO 3166-1 is maintained; each alpha-2 code element allocated to a country name in ISO 3166-1 is also shown in the list in ISO 3166-2.

4.1.3 Where different terms are used to categorize country subdivisions, they are included. Country subdivision names are listed within their category. The terms used to describe such categories are those used by the countries concerned, with their approximate equivalents in English, if required and available. In some cases, a subdivision term is consistently included, as its omission would change the grammatical form of the subdivision name.

EXAMPLE

LT-VL Vilniaus Apskritis

Omitting Apskritis (meaning county in Lithuanian) would result in changing the subdivision name to Vilnius (the city name).

4.1.4 In cases where names of subdivisions are included in another level of regional division, the names of such regional divisions are mentioned and code elements are allocated for reference purposes. Such code elements are shown after the main subdivision names in a separate column.

NOTE The other level of regional division given for reference purposes is not necessarily superior to the main level of administrative subdivision stated but can represent a different e.g. geographical way of subdividing a country.

4.2 Choice of language, romanization, character set

Country subdivision names are given in the official language(s) of the country concerned as expressed in Roman alphabet, and with the provisions as to character set as stated below.

4.1.2 La correspondance exacte avec chacun des noms de pays figurant dans l'ISO 3166-1 est conservée; chaque codet alpha-2 attribué à un nom de pays dans l'ISO 3166-1 figure également dans la liste de l'ISO 3166-2.

4.1.3 Les différents termes utilisés pour désigner les catégories de subdivisions de pays sont mentionnés. Les noms de subdivisions de pays sont répertoriés à l'intérieur de leur catégorie. Les termes employés pour décrire de telles catégories sont ceux qu'utilisent les pays concernés, accompagnés d'un équivalent approximatif en anglais, si nécessaire et disponible. Dans certains cas, le terme qualifiant une subdivision est régulièrement inclus dans le nom, car son omission modifierait la forme grammaticale du nom de la subdivision.

EXAMPLE

LT-VL Vilniaus Apskritis

Si on supprime le terme Apskritis (signifiant comté en lituanien), le nom de la subdivision devient Vilnius (nom de la ville).

4.1.4 Lorsque des noms de subdivisions sont inclus dans un niveau différent de division régionale, les noms de ces divisions régionales sont mentionnés et des codets leur sont attribués à des fins de référence. De tels codets sont reportés après les noms des subdivisions principales dans une colonne séparée.

NOTE Le niveau différent de division régionale donné à des fins de référence n'est pas nécessairement supérieur au niveau principal de la division administrative indiquée, mais peut représenter un autre mode, par exemple géographique, de subdivision du pays.

4.2 Choix de la langue, romanisation, jeu de caractères

Les noms de subdivisions de pays sont donnés dans la ou les langues officielles du pays concerné et sont exprimés en alphabet latin en appliquant, pour le jeu de caractères utilisé, les dispositions définies ci-après.

EXAMPLE

DE-BY Bayern (not: Bavaria)

Where country subdivision names are submitted in non-Roman alphabets, they are shown in this part of ISO 3166 in romanized form, as much as possible in accordance with the relevant International Standards, or otherwise with an indication of the source.

For the country subdivision names listed in this part of ISO 3166, the 26-character Roman alphabet is used, in relevant cases using diacritic signs as contained in the character inventory of ISO/IEC 10646-1 [see 4.4, c)].

4.3 Special provisions: alternative names

4.3.1 In exceptional cases, variants of the same country subdivision name are shown in square brackets beside that name.

4.3.2 In cases where country subdivision names exist in more than one official language, these may be shown with the same code element. The language used is indicated by the relevant ISO 639 two-letter code element.

4.4 Presentation of the list

The list of country subdivision names established in this part of ISO 3166 is arranged in alphabetical order of the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 country code elements. The alphabetical order of country subdivision names is the one provided by the country concerned or the one indicated in the list source of the relevant country, any articles being retained before the name. For each country name the list contains

a) a header which shows

- the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 code element for the country;
- the name of the country in English and French, as set out in ISO 3166-1;
- a description of the subdivision of the country with the relevant term in English and the national language;
- reference to the source of the information;
- when required: reference to romanization system used, specification of alphabetical order for sorting, etc.;
- remarks, if any;

EXEMPLE

DE-BY Bayern (et non pas Bavière)

Lorsque les noms de subdivisions de pays sont écrits dans un alphabet autre que le latin, ils apparaissent dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 sous leur forme romanisée la plus conforme possible aux Normes internationales pertinentes, ou autrement avec l'indication de la référence.

Pour les noms de subdivisions de pays répertoriés dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166, l'alphabet latin de 26 caractères est utilisé avec, dans les cas appropriés, les signes diacritiques figurant dans l'inventaire des caractères de l'ISO/CEI 10646-1 [voir 4.4, c)].

4.3 Clauses spéciales: autres dénominations

4.3.1 Dans des cas exceptionnels, des variantes dans la dénomination d'une même subdivision de pays figurent entre crochets à côté de ce nom.

4.3.2 Lorsque les noms de subdivisions de pays existent dans plusieurs langues officielles, ces noms peuvent figurer avec le même codet. La langue employée est indiquée par le codet à deux lettres correspondant de l'ISO 639.

4.4 Présentation de la liste

La liste des noms de subdivisions de pays élaborée dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 est classée selon l'ordre alphabétique des codets de pays alpha-2 de l'ISO 3166-1. L'ordre alphabétique des noms de subdivisions de pays est celui que fournit le pays concerné ou celui qui est indiqué dans la source de la liste du pays en question, les articles étant conservés devant le nom. Pour chaque nom de pays, la liste comporte

a) un en-tête indiquant

- le codet alpha-2 de l'ISO 3166-1 pour le pays;
- le nom du pays en anglais et en français, comme indiqué dans l'ISO 3166-1;
- une description de la subdivision du pays avec le terme approprié en anglais et dans la langue officielle;
- une référence à la source de l'information;
- si nécessaire: référence au système de romanisation, spécification de l'ordre alphabétique pour le classement, etc.;
- des remarques, le cas échéant;

b) a listing of other level divisions of the country which may be referred to after each subdivision name as a code element in column 3, see under c) below;

c) a list of subdivisions, headed with the term describing the type of subdivision, if there are more than one, and with

— two mandatory columns:

column 1 showing the code element allocated to each subdivision name (see 5.2);

column 2 showing the country subdivision names in the official language of the country concerned, where relevant with diacritic signs according to ISO/IEC 10646-1:1993, tables 1, 2, 3, 5, 31 and 32. This column may be divided into columns 2 a) and 2 b) in cases where there are more than one official languages or more than one romanization systems;

EXAMPLE

column 3 stating the code of another level of regional subdivision, not used as part of the subdivision code element.

5 Principles for allocation of (country subdivision) code elements

5.1 Relationship to national or international code systems

It is desirable that country subdivision code elements allocated in this part of ISO 3166 should reflect code systems already established nationally or internationally. When no code elements have been notified, the ISO 3166/MA allocates appropriate code elements (see clause 6). The sources used by the ISO 3166/MA shall be included in the lists.

5.2 Structure of country subdivision code elements

The country subdivision code elements shall have a maximum length of six characters (including the separator). The coding structure is as follows:

5 Principes d'attribution des codets (pour subdivisions de pays)

5.1 Relations avec les systèmes de codification nationaux et internationaux

Il est souhaitable que les codets des subdivisions de pays attribués dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 correspondent aux systèmes de codification déjà établis aux niveaux national et international. Lorsqu'aucun codet n'a été indiqué, l'ISO 3166/MA attribue les codets appropriés (voir article 6). Les sources utilisées par l'ISO 3166/MA doivent figurer dans les listes.

5.2 Structure des codets des subdivisions de pays

La longueur maximale des codets des subdivisions de pays doit être de six caractères, séparateur inclus. La structure de codage est la suivante:

- a) The first two characters are the alpha-2 country code element provided in ISO 3166-1.
- b) The alpha-2 country code element is followed by a hyphen and the code element of the country subdivision name.
- c) The code element designating the country subdivision name shall consist of one, two or three alphabetical and/or numeric characters.

6 Maintenance

The Maintenance Agency (ISO 3166/MA) established by the ISO Council to maintain ISO 3166, and operating in accordance with guidelines approved by the Council, has the following specific function with regard to ISO 3166-2:

- a) to add and to delete country subdivision names and assign code elements as needed, in accordance with the rules provided;
- b) to advise users and ISO member bodies regarding application of the codes;
- c) to update and disseminate lists of country subdivision names and their code elements;
- d) to maintain a reference list of all code elements for country subdivision names used in ISO 3166-2, and their periods of validity;
- e) to issue and distribute newsletters announcing changes made to the current version of ISO 3166-2;
- f) to administer the reservation of code elements.

Changes to this part of ISO 3166 are the responsibility of the ISO 3166/MA and become effective immediately upon publication. They are authoritative amendments which form an integral part of this part of ISO 3166.

The following criteria shall be observed by the ISO 3166/MA for changes to the list of country subdivision names in this part of ISO 3166 and their code elements, and for reservations of code elements.

6.1 Changes of country subdivision names

All additions, deletions and alterations in the list of country subdivision names shall be made on the basis of information identified in 4.1.

6 Mise à jour

Dans le cadre de l'ISO 3166-2, l'Agence de mise à jour (ISO 3166/MA) mise en place par le Conseil de l'ISO pour mettre à jour l'ISO 3166, et qui fonctionne conformément aux directives approuvées par le Conseil, doit remplir les fonctions particulières suivantes:

- a) ajouter et supprimer des noms de subdivision et attribuer des codets, si nécessaire, conformément aux règles fixées;
- b) conseiller les utilisateurs et les organes membres de l'ISO, eu égard à l'application des codes;
- c) mettre à jour et diffuser les listes des noms des subdivisions de pays et de leurs codets;
- d) tenir à jour une liste de référence de tous les codets associés aux noms des subdivisions de pays utilisés dans l'ISO 3166-2, et surveiller leurs périodes de validité;
- e) publier et diffuser des lettres d'information pour faire connaître les changements apportés à la version actuelle de l'ISO 3166-2;
- f) gérer la réservation de codets.

Les changements de la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 se font sous la responsabilité de l'ISO 3166/MA et prennent effet dès leur publication. Partie intégrante de la présente partie de l'ISO 3166, ces amendements font autorité.

Les critères suivants doivent être respectés par l'ISO 3166/MA pour les changements de la liste des noms des subdivisions de pays dans la présente partie de l'ISO 3166 et de leurs codets, ainsi que pour les réservations de codets.

6.1 Changement des noms des subdivisions de pays

Tout ajout, retrait ou changement dans la liste des noms des subdivisions de pays doit se faire en fonction des informations identifiées en 4.1.

6.2 Alterations to country subdivision code elements

The Maintenance Agency shall endeavour to maintain stability in the lists of code elements. A significant change of a country subdivision name may require the ISO 3166/MA to alter the code element after appropriate consultation with the authorities concerned.

6.3 Reservation of code elements for country subdivision names

Code elements that have been changed should not be reallocated during a period of at least five years after the change. The exact period is determined in each case on the basis of the extent to which the previous code element was used.

Code elements may be reserved, in exceptional cases, for country subdivision names which the ISO 3166/MA has decided not to include in this part of ISO 3166 but for which an interchange requirement exists. Before such code elements are reserved, advice from the relevant authority shall be sought.

A list of reserved code elements and a record of changes shall be kept by the ISO 3166/MA Secretariat and is available on request.

7 Guidelines for users

7.1 Special provisions

7.1.1 General

Users sometimes need to extend or alter the use of country subdivision code elements for special purposes. The following provisions give guidance for meeting such needs within the framework of this part of ISO 3166. In every case the MA should be informed.

7.1.2 Subsets

If users do not need to use the entire list of country subdivision names from this part of ISO 3166, they may select those that they require to create their own subset.

7.1.3 Aggregations

In the exceptional case that users need to group together country subdivision names included in this part of ISO 3166, and they require a code

7 Principes directeurs pour les utilisateurs

7.1 Clauses spéciales

7.1.1 Généralités

7.1.4 User-assigned code elements

If users need code elements to represent country subdivision names not included in this part of ISO 3166, they should avoid code elements already allocated. These users should inform the ISO 3166/MA¹⁾ of any code elements selected.

7.1.5 Redefinitions

If, in exceptional cases, a user finds that the meaning of an existing code element from this part of ISO 3166 needs to be redefined, the ISO 3166/MA¹⁾ should be consulted.

7.1.6 Information interchange

When country subdivision names and code elements are derived as a subset of this part of ISO 3166 or are user-defined (see 7.1.2 and 7.1.4), it is essential that all parties involved in such interchange be informed of the contents of the subsets concerned and of the relevant descriptions of user-defined code elements.

7.2 Notification of use of this part of ISO 3166

Users should notify the ISO 3166/MA and the national standards body, where appropriate, of their use of this part of ISO 3166, in order that they may be informed of future changes or other actions (e.g. through the ISO 3166 *Newsletter*). For this purpose, a copy of the user's implementation document or code element list should be transmitted to the ISO 3166/MA Secretariat¹⁾.

7.3 Advice regarding use

The ISO 3166/MA is available for consultation and assistance on the use of country subdivision names in coded form.

Annex B (informative)

Character inventory: Guidance for users in cases of difficulties with representing diacritics

The character inventory used in the list of country subdivision names in clause 8 of this part of ISO 3166 is defined by Tables 1, 2, 3, 5, 31 and 32 of ISO/IEC 10646-1:1993 [see 4.4, c)].

Apart from the 26 basic Roman letters, these tables include a large number of characters which are based on the basic 26 Roman characters but which are modified by diacritic marks. If for any reasons characters modified by diacritic signs cannot be reproduced by the equipment used in applications of this part of ISO 3166, the diacritic signs should be ignored and the corresponding single Roman letter should be used as shown in the example given below.
